



2008 SUMMER BASEBALL CAMPS

The Summer Baseball Camps offer youngsters in grades fourth through eighth the opportunity to receive the latest in skill instruction and player development. **Palatine's Head Baseball Coach Paul Belo** leads the Summer Baseball Camp. The 2000 IHSBCA "Area Coach of the Year" has been recognized on the local and national level. Touted by The Chicago Sun-Times as "The best young coach in the area" coach Belo's teams have twice been named to USA Today's pre-season top fifty. Under Coach Belo's 11 year tenure forty players have advanced to the collegiate level. Belo's teams have averaged over twenty wins per year, made three final eight appearances, acclaimed three sectional, three regional, three divisional and one conference title. The camp is also instructed by assistant coaches, along with current and former players will foster an environment that can only lead to a positive learning experience.

CAMP FORMAT

Campers will receive individual and small group instruction daily, **with an intense concentration on fundamentals common to all position players (hitting, bunting, throwing, fielding and running)**. Each camper will be assigned to a "team" which will travel as a group through various instructional "stations".
